New Light Community

Recently Anza Charity coordinator, Udion Kang and Anza President Dain Leathem met Sr Martina, director of New Light Community Shelter. New Light is the new charity Anza decided to support. New Light is a shelter for people living with HIV-AIDS and their children. It is the only place in Seoul to provide a shelter for people with HIV. It was founded by the late Sr. Miriam Cousins, who came to South Korea in 1971 and devoted her life to helping the underprivileged until she passed away. The shelter couldn't get the government funding since its regulation and requirement make it difficult to include people who really need the place. The New Light Community needs renovating the kitchen of the facility, which was built in the 1970s.
