Today, April 25, marks the annual commemoration of the first major military action seen by Australian and New Zealand troops during World War I. To mark ANZAC Day, ANZA Korea representatives joined the Australian and New Zealand Embassies and community members in attending the Dawn Service at the War Memorial of Korea.

Battle of Gapyeong Commemoration and Scholarship Ceremony

On Friday, April 22, ANZA Korea President Dain Leathern and Charity Coordinator Udion Kang visited Gapyeong to mark the 71st anniversary of the Battle of Gapyeong through a special commemorative ceremony at the Australia and New Zealand Memorial.

The annual event honours the brave soldiers from Australia and New Zealand, who fought alongside South Korea during the Korean War, by visiting the memorial and donating education scholarships to local Gapyeong High and Middle School students.

Attendees included Australian Ambassador, H.E Catherine Raper, New Zealand Ambassador H.E. Philip Turner, defence teams of both countries, and ANZA Korea, AustCham Korea and Kiwi Chamber representatives.


