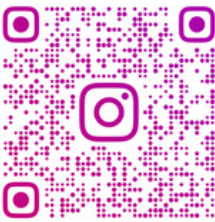

About Anna's House

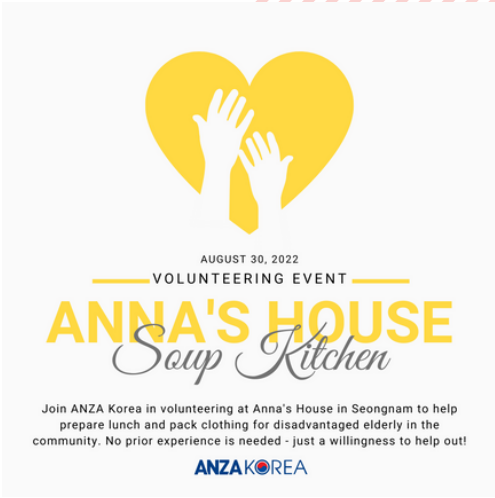
