Seoul Halloween Crowd Crush 

October 2022

An official period of mourning from October 30 to November 5 was declared as a result of the Itaewon tragedy. ANZA halted all social media promotions and postponed the delivery of the monthly newsletter out of respect for those mourning. ANZA Korea President Sunny Myung shared her condolences: "On behalf of ANZA Korea, we are all deeply saddened by the heartbreaking incident in Itaewon on October 29. Our thoughts and prayers are with everyone who has been affected by this sorrowful tragedy.

We send our deepest condolences to the families who have lost their loved ones and wish for a full recovery for all those who were injured. We have been reaching out to the community to support and meaningfully engage with our members wherever possible. We hope this can help to bring us all together to overcome our grief and struggles during these challenging times. If you need any help or support, please do not hesitate to contact us. Pray for Itaewon. ANZA Korea stands as one with Korea."
